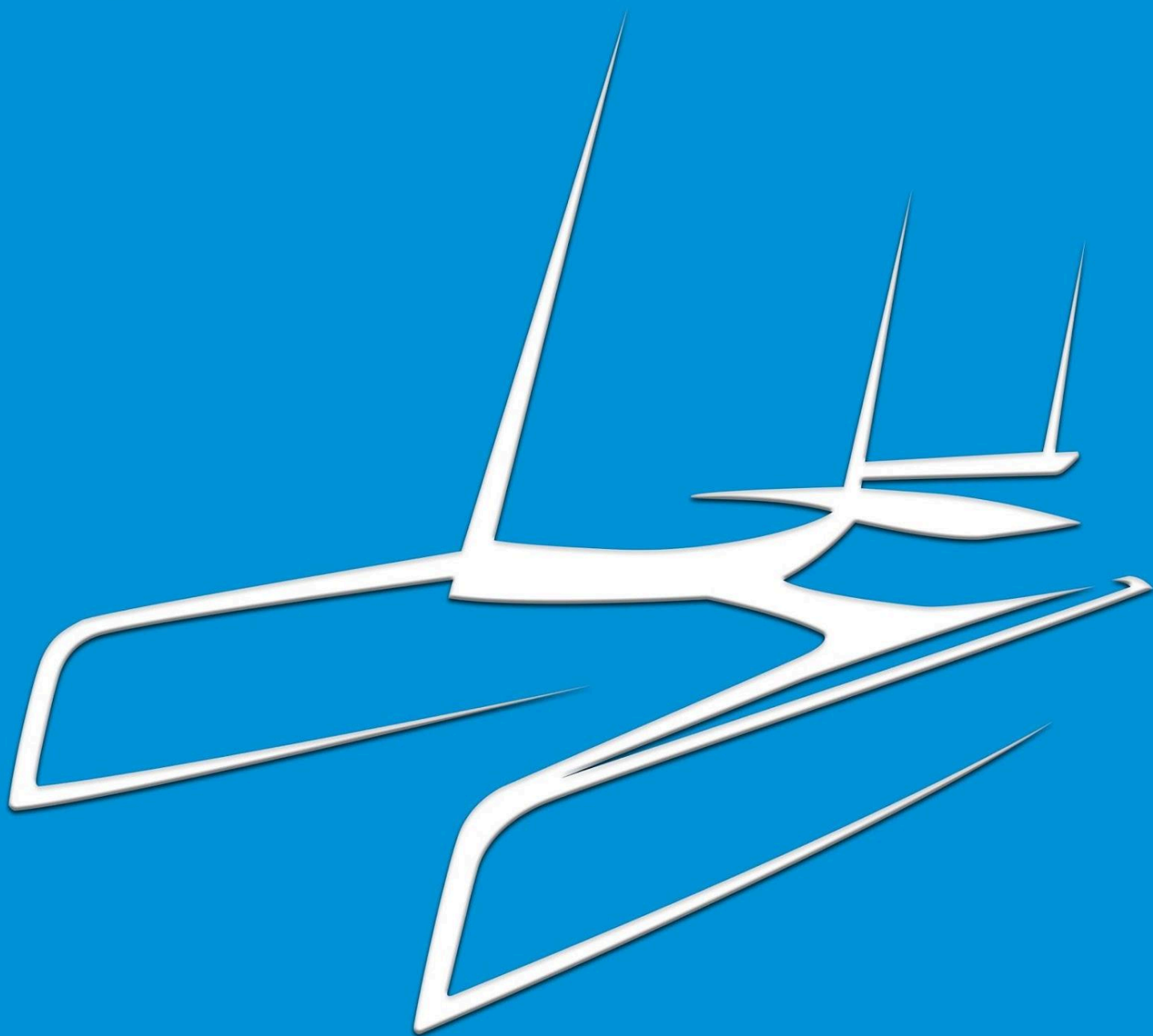

2. VENUE AND DATES

Multihull Cup is held in at Port Adriano on Mallorca between 26th and 28th September 2025.

3. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the following rules:

Racing Rules of Sailing as defined in the World Sailing 2021-2025.

Current International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.

The Sailing Instructions issued by the Organizing Authority.

4. ELEGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Entries will be limited to performance sailing multihulls of a length >15m.

The Organising Authority reserves the right to accept entries from yachts out with the above parameters if they deem that it will add to the event.

The entry fee is €2,500 to be received before 1st July 2025, any entries received thereafter will be accepted at the discretion of the organisers and incur a 25% late entry charge.

Entrants are required to present the following during registration on Thursday 25th September 2025 between 1400hrs and 1600hrs at the Multihull Cup base, Regatta Village, Port Adriano:

- Registration details signed by Boat Captain.
- A valid [ORCmh](#) Measurement Certificate.
- A copy of current Yacht Insurance Certificate including third party cover when racing.

- A list of crew members and, where applicable, the appropriate sailing license from the National Authority.
- Name and phone number of contact person ashore.
- Photo release form – signed

Entrants are required to make the boat available for measuring by an ORC representative on the 25th September at a time to be agreed between the boat captain and the ORC representative directly.

Furthermore, by signing the registration document, the boat captain agrees that an ORC representative may scrutineer the boat at any time during the regatta.

5. SCHEDULE

Three days of inshore and coastal racing with minimum of one race per day.

Each morning the Organising Authority will propose the course for that day. Where possible it will follow the planned schedule detailed in the Sailing Instructions, but they reserve the right to propose alternative courses, as long as the proposal is agreed by a majority of entrants.

7. SCORING

One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

A boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores.

8. SAFETY

1. The ISAF Offshore Special Regulations Multihull Category 4.
2. Participants undertake to carry on board, under their own responsibility, the yacht's updated mandatory documentation, as well as the appropriate certification for handling the yacht and the type of navigation to be carried out.

9. BERTHS

Participating yachts will be entitled to free berthing from 24th 12:00h to 29th 12:00h September 2025 inclusive.

Where possible, and dependent on length, beam and draft, the yachts will be berthed as close to each other from 26th to 28th September inclusive. Port Adriano reserves the right to allocate different berths outside of the above times but will make every effort to minimise yacht movements.

All yachts will be required to confirm their entry date and time directly with Port Adriano.

10. LIABILITY

All yachts participating in the regatta do so at their own risk and their own liability.

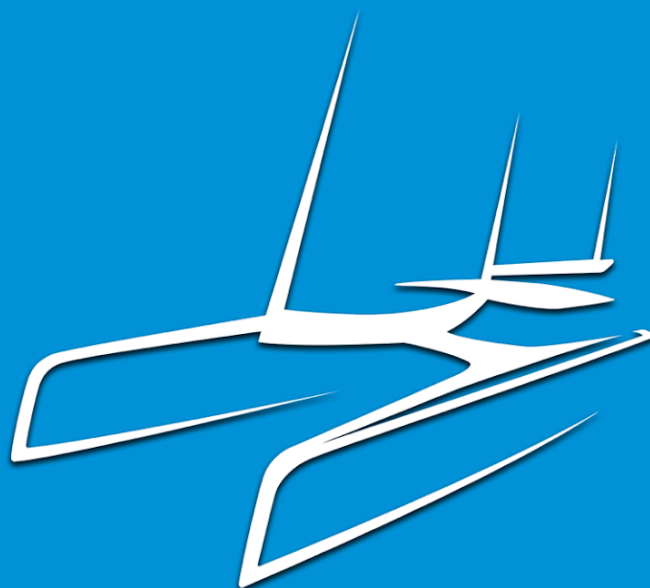
The Organising Committee or any other person or body involved in organising the event, will not be held liable for any losses, damages, injuries, or harm sustained by persons or things, both ashore and at sea, as a result of the participation in the regatta referred to in this Notice of Race.

Attention is drawn to Fundamental Rule 3 DECISION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE RACE, of part 1 of the RRS, establishing:

"The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

11. TROPHIES

The class winner's trophies will be presented to the owner of the yacht with the lowest aggregate score over all races in each class. The trophy is to be kept by the winner, with no requirement to return it for the following year. Trophies for the other entrants will be presented on the same basis as above.
